New Zealand Metrologist Awards

The NZ MSA branch are offering two awards to recognise excellence in the field of metrology from up-and-coming junior individuals and experienced metrologists who stand out amongst their peers with respect to technical knowledge, quality focus, client focus, innovation, and leadership in their field of metrology.

The awards are for **Emerging Metrologist** and **The NZ Metrologist Award 2022**. These are annual awards that will be awarded on a date or MSA event* as determined the year prior and advertised on the MSA website and in NZ MSA news. The winner will receive a certificate, prize package and a trophy.

Nomination Criteria - Emerging Metrologist Award

Nominations must be for an individual who has been in a metrology related industry for less than five years, who stands out amongst others in respect to technical knowledge, quality focus, client focus. Nominations must be received by 31 January 2022, and award presented on World Metrology Day, 20th May 2022.

Nomination Criteria – The NZ Metrologist Award

Nominations must be for an individual who has been in a metrology related industry for more than five years, who stands out amongst others in respect to technical knowledge, quality focus, client focus, innovation, and leadership. Nominations must be received by 31 December 2022, and award presented at the MSA Conference 20-23 February 2023 held in Wellington.

Terms & Conditions -

- The entrant must meet the criteria regarding age at the time of application and can be either self-nominated or third party nominated.
- The entrant must be supported by their organisation.
- The entrant gives MSA permission to use any of the material provided for publicity and promotional purposes.
- Entrants must be based in a New Zealand metrology related industry.
- Entries shall be provided in electronic format and shall include a high-quality jpeg profile image.
- The judging panel reserves the right to ask for additional information which must be provided by the date specified.
- Finalists may be requested to discuss their application and demonstrate their knowledge of metrology practices at a meeting (virtual or otherwise) with the judging panel.
- Finalists shall meet any expenses incurred when attending a meeting with the judging panel.
- Award winners must attend the formal award presentation.
- Previous entrants and/or winners may re-enter so long as they meet the conditions of entry.
- The judging panel will consist of the current New Zealand MSA Committee members, and their decision shall be deemed final.
